This position requires an individual with a deep level of organizational knowledge and experience. This individual must have the ability to lead leaders, navigate the political atmosphere that surrounds private and individual charter schools, organize and interpret educational data, develop and maintain district / network organizational strategies, and work with large scale budgets. This position requires a life commitment and has a high level of accountability. This individual will have hiring and firing authority second only to the OUISN Founder and Board of Directors.

The requirements for this position consist of the following:

- **Management of all network programs and OUISN school Principals / Project Managers and support staff**
- **Network facilitation of the Project-Based learning environment using the M.A.K.E. Learning System**
- **Network record keeping and adherence to the Wisconsin State and Outlook University Independent School Network processes and procedures**
- **Meeting the objective criteria set for network accountability**
- **Developing organizational strategies as a function of Board goal setting**
- **Facilitation of accreditation requirements and standards**
- **Completion of projects and tasks as assigned by the OUISN Founder and Board of Directors**

To qualify for this position the candidate must have a Master's degree in administrative leadership or be enrolled in an administration certification program, and at least 5 years of administrative experience. A district administrative license, Ph.D, or Ed.D is preferred.

This position is a year-round commitment.
